- 4. Fundraising plans: Teri Kantor Fundraising Committee chair, will update us about upcoming plans at our next meeting. Thanks to Melanie Eriksen for coordinating the Purdy's Christmas fundraiser.
- 5. Proposed Projects or Expenditures-Tony Martino
 - Discussion on Student Chromebooks:
 - Current enrollment:
 814 students in Junior High, 8 Chromebook carts (310 Chromebooks) =
 1:3 ratio for chromebook to students
 - 657 students in High School, 6 Chromebook carts (230 Chromebooks)
 - 15 Chromebooks in the office
 - 20 Chromebooks in the exam room
 - 575 total Chromebooks with 1471 students equates to about 39%
 - 4 additional carts of Chromebooks would be needed to achieve a 1:2 ratio of Chromebook to student. Estimated cost ~\$200 000 total.
 - Diploma exams will be all digital. Critical for the school to increase the availability of chromebooks to meet student needs.
 - Other tech: 2 computer labs that will require updating in the next 3-5 vears
 - Funding Request: 1-2 Chromebook carts at ~\$25 000 each
 - Discussed other outstanding requests: Decals for the bus (~\$3000), next casino date is 2026, discussed ensuring we hold some funds for future requests.
 - Proposed that PFA provide \$35000 now
 - Move for \$35,000 to be allocated for purchase of Chromebook carts from the Gaming account -by Gill, seconded by Len
 - -decals will be pursued by Jackie for more information
