- School Growth Plan and Achievement results
 - Accountability Pillar, Satisfaction Survey and Tell Them from Me Surveys all show tremendous growth from last year
 - PAT results were exceptional...above District and Province in all measures except K&E
 Math. Equal or Positive results on Regression Analysis
 - O Diploma Results are not where we want them. Intensive focus on pedagogical shifts are the academic focus of our HS subject area teachers moving forward. While there were some subjects that showed improvement, there were many that either showed declining achievement or continued low achievement. Regression data was not positive, which is of concern given the fact it is largely the same cohort of students from JH to SH.
 - School Goals remain essentially the same as last year, with focus on:
 - Academic rigor and heightened achievement through differentiation, personalization and in-depth data-analysis. Professional development to improve pedagogy and the incorporation of more successful strategies of instruction and assessment will be our focus.
 - Continued focus on school culture through attention to student mental health, establishing authentic and supportive relationships with students, and focused attention to breaking down negative norms of behavior to empower students to be leaders in making school more safe and caring
 - Enhance our Catholic witness in ways that are meaningfully engaging to our students, so as to fully realize our mission as Catholic educators.
