- **4.** Short <u>coaches meeting</u> in the staff room at 8:45-9:00 a.m.
- 5. All athletes are to partake in the opening ceremonies in their Halloween Costumes.
- **6.** Please remind your team members to stay in the gyms, cafeteria, or Team Athlete Room. All other areas of the school are off limits.
- **7. SMASH DINNER:** We will be hosting a Pasta Dinner and Pepsi in the Cafeteria from 5:00-7:15pm followed by SMASH FEST 7:30-9:00pm on Friday evening.
- **8.** All teams/participants need to be present for **"SMASH-Fest"**, Friday evening from 7:30 pm 9:00 pm for fun mixers, activities and draw prizes.
 - ** Attendance is Mandatory!!
- **9. Team Room:** Please have your teams store bags and equipment in the cafeteria. Your host/hostess will show you to your table, which will always remain supervised (by parent volunteers). We will do our best to secure this area but will not take responsibility for any items that are left unsecured.
- **10. Parking:** Parking is limited around the school. If you are coming by team van, you may park Teacher Parking Lot North of the school. Alternatively, you could park on the street along the west field (just north of the school). If you have a coach/bus, the street on the west is your only option.
- **11. Coaches Room:** Sandwiches, fruit, snacks, chili, pulled pork, soup, and beverages will be available to coaches in the staff room during the tournament.

13. Tournament Play Guidelines

- a. All matches are best of 3.
- b. Major Officials supplied by EVOA.
- c. Canada volleyball rules apply.
- d. Where ties occur at the completion of round robin play, the following procedure will take place, as per standard CVA guidelines.
 - i. The team having the best ratio of won/lost matches, considering matches between the tied teams, will be ranked higher.
 - ii. The team having the best ratio of won/lost games, considering matches played between the tied teams, will be ranked higher.
 - iii. The team having the best ratio of won/lost games, considering all matches of the round, will be ranked higher.
 - iv. The team having the best ratio of points for/against, considering games played between the tied teams, will be ranked higher.
 - v. The team having the best ratio of points for/against, considering all games played during the round, will be ranked higher.
 - vi. As determined by the Organizing Committee (e.g., extra game, toss of coin, etc.)
- **14. Format:** Four 5-team round robin Draw (10 boys and 10 girls Teams); Teams are 3A Schools from across Alberta; One game per gym with main court nets only

SMASH-FEST 2024 (Please fill out google LINK for Participants in Email)

Each team will select 5 players to participate in the Smash-Fest activities. 2 players to play "Royal Court"; 3 players (2 hitters and 1 setter) for the "Ground Pounders Competition". Players should participate in only one of the activities.

ROYAL COURT GAME

- 1. Co-ed teams will be created as outlined below. One player from each team listed participating in that event. Ex) Team 1 girl from LSL, 1 girl from Grande Prairie, 1 boy from Beaverlodge, 1 boy from Barrhead.
- 2. Co-ed teams will be randomly placed in order. The first team will assume Royal Court and the second team will be challengers.
- 3. The net will be set between Men and Women's heights
- 4. Challengers will serve to "royalty" to begin the rally.
- 5. The winners of the rally will assume Royal Court and continue to defend the court until beaten by challengers.
- 6. Standard volleyball rules will apply self officiated.
- 7. The game will continue for 15 minutes. When the score clock sounds, the team that has possession of the Royal Court will be the champions.
- 8. If the horn sounds during a rally, the rally will continue until finished. The winner of that rally will be declared champions.

Royal court champions will receive prizes.

GROUND POUNDERS COMPETITION.

- 1. Women's competition first. Men's second
- 2. All players will warm up for 5 minutes
- 3. All hits will come from the power position. The radar gun will be set up for cross court hits
- 4. 1 hitter will toss to the setter who will then set to his/her other hitter. The hitters will then trade spots for the next attack. After both attacks, the next team in line will take their turn.
- 6. Each hitter will get three attempts.
- 7. The ball must land in-bounds to have its speed recorded
- 8. Fastest recorded hit wins!
- 9. Nets will be set at appropriate heights for men's and women's competition
- ** There is a Keeper Trophy for the hardest hitter (male and female).
