1.0 School Council's Objectives / Purpose / Roles

- Discussion included how best to implement learning via remote sessions and how it affects students and teachers.
- Keeping religion, faith and its teachings via strategies within the curriculum; currently, students have pre-recorded prayers that they've written as part of the daily routine;
