We look forward to the month of November as we observe Remembrance Day and get back to our school routines as a Louis St. Laurent community.



We have had to make some changes to a few anticipated dates. In light of our recent return, we will not be undertaking parent/teacher interviews on November 27. Should you wish to set up a time to speak to your child's teacher about any concerns you may have, we encourage you to do so at any time and our teachers are always open to speaking with you. We look forward to the next round of parent/teacher interviews as scheduled on April 23.



We will also be re-scheduling our professional development day for staff that was previously set to take place on November 28. This will instead take place on a date in the new year to be determined. We will communicate this date with you in the coming weeks. This of course will mean that there WILL be school for students on November 28. We appreciate your understanding.



As has been communicated to you by the Division, there will be no January PAT's, CSA's or Diploma Exams. In the senior high, the last day of instruction in semester 1 will be Friday, January 23. Monday, January 26 will be Conflict Exam and Timetable Resolution Day and Tuesday, January 27 will be Mark Submission Day. Wednesday, January 28 is a PD Day in the senior high. Therefore, there will be no school for senior high students on these three days. Junior high students WILL attend school on all of these days. Thursday, January 29 will be the first day of semester 2 in senior high. Due to labour disruption, no final exams will be administered in the senior high. Only unit finals will be administered. These protocols and timelines are consistent across senior high schools throughout the Division.
