  - a. Enrolment projections: likely over 1400 next year

- 2. There will be changes to the schedule next year for junior high:
- One less option per semester additional time will be given to core subjects (Science, Social, Math). Teachers have been requesting more instructional time in cores as many hours can be lost to celebrations and activities
- JH academy kids-will lose their options next year (the only way they could do that would be to lose the work out block)
- SPARK happens in only one semester, so it will be a bit different
- Spanish program
- There may be an adjusted Thursday schedule when events occur retaining the four blocks but reducing the instructional time. This eliminates cancelling blocks to protect the instructional time.
