School Admin Report & Presentations <u>Student Services</u> Mrs. Arksey, Learning Coach and Student Services Department Head provided an overview of the Student Services department. • ~21% increase in IPP's this year (increase to 136 from 108) • 61 FNMI students • 23 Ukrainian students (from 17 families). Intake is through ECSD's One World One Center. • 177 English as Additional Language (EAL) students • 9 refugee students (not including Ukrainians) • 135 referrals received for Mental Health Supports/MDT. Most referrals are for Teacher Counsellor, second most is for Social Worker.
